The Bowling center of the Sports Unit, is where the World Games have been held in 2013

2. Accommodation and Lodging

FEDECOBOL designated the **NH ROYAL CALI** hotel as the headquarters of all the delegations. It is located approximately 20 minutes from the competition stage, has enough rooms to accommodate all the participants. The hotel is a 4-star category **** and will also be the venue for cultural activities

DOUBLE Accommodation: **USD. 130.00.-** Night value.

SINGLE accommodation **USD 140,00.-** night value

No triple/quadruple accommodation for biosafety protocol reasons

All rooms include taxes and breakfast, parking, LED TV. See website for more information.

The hotel is located at **Carrera 100 B No, 11A - 99 Cali, Colombia**

IMPORTANT: For the organization and management of reservations, these must be made only through the **Colombian Bowling Federation (FEDECOBOL)**, who will directly handle the issue of accommodation. After the date of registration of accommodation, we will not be able to guarantee the same price.

Those who do not follow this procedure will lose the right to the benefits of transportation and the socio-cultural activities of the event.

3. Registration

Entry-Fee

Athletes	: US\$ 150.00
Coaches and delegates	: US\$ 150.00
Companions	: US\$ 130.00

Note: All entry-fee will be in cash only

4. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to participate in the senior and super senior Pan American Championships, Federations must be in good standing with their IBF and PANAM membership fess.

All athletes participating in this Pan American Championship must be nationals of the country of the Panam Bowling member federation they represent; To prove this, they must present a copy of their valid passport.

All disputes related to the provisions of the previous paragraph will be resolved by the Executive Committee of Panam Bowling.

When the formation of teams refers to an athlete **in the senior category**, he or she must **turn 50 years old or older in the year 2026**

When the formation of teams refers to an athlete **Super senior category**, he or she must **turn 60 years old or older in the year 2026**

5. TEAM FORMATION

Each country affiliated with Panam Bowling will be able to participate with **a maximum ONE TEAM**

The teams will be made up of 2 men and 2 women in the super senior category and 4 men and/or four women in the senior category

Incomplete representations may be submitted by Countries, who will participate in events where they are able to do so.

In addition, the Delegation may be made up of:

One (1) delegate per branch and category,
Up to two (2) technicians per branch and category

6. IMPORTANT DATES:

The date to numerically register athletes is until May **29, 2026**

To separate **hotel** until **June 30, 2026**.

To register nominally until **July 31, 2026**.
